- Own product definition across multiple enterprise modules — translating stakeholder requirements into specifications, data models, and staged implementation plans, removing the back-and-forth between the engineering team and the client.
- Design and build enterprise systems on .NET 8 with Domain-Driven Design, Clean Architecture, and CQRS, including REST and SOAP integration layers and SQL Server stored procedures and views for high-volume processing and reporting.
- Introduced an AI-assisted development workflow across the team — codified engineering conventions, structured specifications, and automated post-implementation review — raising delivery speed without degrading architectural quality.
- Own the company's entire infrastructure alongside development: self-hosted GitLab, network policy and firewall on FortiGate, Windows Server and Ubuntu hosts, IIS deployments, DNS, reverse proxy, and mail infrastructure.
- Model business processes in BPMN and implement them on an internal BPMS engine, matching the client's real administrative workflows rather than generic templates.
- Led security hardening for AFTA compliance — access control, secure API design, input validation, and audit logging, aligned with OWASP Top 10 and ISO/IEC 27001.

Enterprise platform managing the complete lifecycle of transactions and contracts, built from the ground up.

- Architected a platform of 148 business modules on CQRS, DDD, and Clean Architecture over .NET 8 — more than 3,500 REST endpoints against a 930-table domain model on EF Core 8.
- Designed a role-based access control model with endpoint-level granularity, alongside JWT authentication and AES encryption, meeting the security requirements of a banking environment.
- Built messaging and real-time infrastructure with MassTransit over RabbitMQ, Redis-backed SignalR, and Hangfire, isolating heavy processing from the user request path.
- Established an AI-assisted delivery pipeline — 14 codified engineering-convention skills and a requirements — data model — design — staged build — automated review cycle — making a domain of this size deliverable by three developers.

- Maintain close to 6,000 xUnit tests alongside Playwright and Vitest end-to-end coverage, running under GitHub Actions CI on every pull request.

- Built a ticketing platform for collecting requirements, bug reports, and feature requests from end users, with a technical and business review workflow on each ticket.
- Connected approved items to Claude Code through MCP as structured specifications — automating the path from end-user request to the start of development.
- Integrated Active Directory for admin authentication, plus Telegram and Bale bots for automatic ticket creation and task generation in Azure TFS.
- Deployed a Stalwart mail server on Windows Server with SPF/DKIM/PTR configuration and an IIS reverse proxy to provide the system's transactional email capability after migration.
